Thank you for submitting the additional materials we requested for your application to u.lab 2x. We've reviewed your application, and feel your team would make a great addition to the Lab. We are excited to invite you to participate!

u.lab 2x will kick off in February 2021. As the calendar year comes to a close and we take time to rest before that launch, here are some things to think about.

Planning Ahead

The u.lab 2x materials and community will be hosted on the Sutra platform. We will share the syllabus and onboard you to the platform in January. Each month's module will give you access to materials to digest and methodologies to practice as a Core Team. On your own schedule, you will lead your Extended Team through the process. The u.lab team will hold joint Zoom sessions at four points during the course, on the dates below (please mark these in your calendar):

Co-initiating: February 18th

Co-Sensing: March 18th

Presencing: April 15th

Prototyping: May 13th

Core Team members can expect to commit 4-5 hours per week toward u.lab 2x, varying across months. Weeks in which teams are applying methodologies will require more time, while others will require less.

Extended Team members can expect up to 2-3 hours per week.

Build a Container

In January, please take some time to get to know your team. Together, we invite you to further clarify your shared intentions for the program. For instance, reflect on:

- WHAT is the **initiative** you feel called to create?
- WHY does it matter? **What system** do you want to impact?
- HOW can you **prototype** your idea over four months, to learn what you need to advance it?
- WHO do you need to **involve, listen and reach out to** (stakeholders, partners, etc.)?

Your core team should continue outreach to potential extended team members—the group of stakeholders who can play a key role in helping you move your initiative forward. Extended team members participate in some of the u.lab 2x journey along with the core team; you will choose how to guide them through this experience, with the support and resources provided. Together, your core and extended team should consist of 7-15 people participating in u.lab 2x.

Theory U

Not all of your team may be familiar with Theory U. That's okay, but it will help to start in February with a common vocabulary and mental models. Team members looking for a quick, detailed introduction or recap will find value in the U.Academy course "[Meet Theory U](#)" on February 2nd. You can also review this short [video series](#). Of course, all content from [u.lab 1x](#) will remain available on edX until May 2021, and it isn't too late for new team members to enroll.

We strongly encourage all core team members to read [The Essentials of Theory U \(2018\)](#) before starting the u.lab 2x journey.
